**JOB SUMMARY:** Under general supervision, loads, unloads and safely drives fuel trucks. Conducts vehicle and load inspections, ensuring loads are secure and all regulations are met.

The following duties are intended to provide a representative summary of the major duties and responsibilities and ARE NOT intended to serve as a comprehensive list of all duties performed by all employees in this classification. Incumbent(s) may not be required to perform all duties listed and may be required to perform additional, position-specific duties.

## REPRESENTATIVE DUTIES

Loads heavy equipment onto lowboy for transportation, including proper cargo securement and binding. Tarps, chains, and straps own load. Ensures the load is clean and secure prior to transporting.

Safely operates commercial motor vehicles; hauling fuel to different locations.

Conducts pre-trip and post- trip vehicle inspections

Ensures the transported equipment complies with DOT regulations

Performs routine maintenance on equipment and motorized vehicles to ensure proper working condition. Assures security alarms, fire/smoke alarms, and carbon monoxide detectors are operational. Forwards damaged or expired items to appropriate personnel.

Performs other duties as assigned or required.
