JOB SUMMARY: Under the direct supervision of a lead worker/operations supervisor, performing environmental remediation work and clean up operations.

REPRESENTATIVE DUTIES

Operate heavy equipment for excavations and loading soils, bulldozing to grade and placing backfill.

Operates two or more types of power equipment such as: front-end loaders, dozers, hydraulic excavators, highway and off-highway trucks, compressors, and pumps.

Will be required to operate the specific equipment listed above safely and efficiently. Expected to assist in maintenance of vehicles and equipment. Must follow daily work schedules and plan. Must follow policies/procedures and experience to operate equipment in a safe and productive manner. Maybe required to complete forms and documents related to the project. Expected to report to work on short notice if called when off duty.

Performs other duties as assigned.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

Forty hour OSHA certification and current eight hour refresher and have applicable health and safety training. Must have valid driver's license.

MINIMUM PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS

The following demands are representative of those that must be met by an employee to successfully perform the essential functions of this job. Must be able to lift approximately 75 pounds. Climbing and extensively walking can be expected. This is a field position with considerable potential for exposures to a variety of physical hazards particularly noise, truck traffic and mounting equipment.
